Scrum is currently the most widely used Agile approach to software development. Scrum focuses primarily on the team process. But what if you want to scale the Agile concept for program and portfolio level?

The Scaled Agile Framework®, known as SAFe®, offers help!

The framework addresses the roles, teams, activities and artifacts that you need when scaling up your Agile approach.

In the training SAFe for Teams you learn Scrum, XP, Lean practices, aimed at the team and program level of SAFe. In addition to general SAFe, Lean and Agile knowledge, we will look at the roles and responsibilities within the teams, managing backlogs, running sprints in SAFe, technical practices and plan a program Increment (PI).

Who should attend the SAFe® for Teams

This training is aimed at anyone who is involved in an Agile Release Train, notably software developers, testers, product owners and Scrum masters.

The SAFe Practitioner exam is included in the training. You will take the exam online at a location determined by yourself (but within 10 days after completion of the training). When you pass the exam will receive a year's membership to the Scaled Agile Academy. In addition, you will have access to the protected SAFe Practitioner section of the website.
