What is UX Awareness

To create a positive User Experience (UX) is the key to the success of a product. It pays off to give attention to all the aspects that influence the User Experience, to get the users satisfied and loyal towards the product or brand. - Entrepreneurs: Build user-friendly products from the ground up.
- Quality Assurance Testers: Test products for usability and ensure they meet UX standards.
- Agile Coaches: Guide teams in integrating UX practices within Agile frameworks.
