What is Agile PM for Scrum

Projects often take place in the complex domain with many uncertainties. Therefore, an agile approach is often a good choice. When developing project products, Scrum is the most commonly used approach. But how do you combine Scrum with project management? What is the role of the steering committee and the project manager? How do you handle overall project planning in a project with multiple Scrum teams? What is the relationship between project manager and product owner? In the Agile PM for Scrum course you will get all the answers.

- Project Managers: Learn how to effectively combine Scrum and projects management.
- Scrum Masters: Gain a deeper understanding of your role within the project management framework.
- Product Owners: Understand your relationship with the project manager and how to work together effectively.
- Steering Committee Members: Learn how to guide the direction of Scrum agile projects.
- Team Members: Understand your role within the Scrum framework and how it fits into the wider project management structure.

Prerequisites

Participants should have prior knowledge of the concept of agile (the four core values and the twelve principles) and the Scrum framework (at the level of PSM I or PSPO I). Although these topics are also covered in the book that accompanies the course and are also exam topics, we do not spend time on them during the course. If you lack this prior knowledge, take our Scrum Master or Professional Scrum Master course first.
